



## Scholarship Programs of the International Visegrad Fund

The International Visegrad Fund offers Master's and Post-Master's scholarships for scholars from Croatia and other countries of Central, Southeast Europe and countries of the Eastern Partnership for periods of 1 to 4 semesters who wish to study at accredited public or private universities or institutes of the respective national academies of sciences in the Visegrad Group (V4) countries (i.e., the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland or Slovakia).

Successful applicants will receive **scholarships of €2,300/semester** and the corresponding host universities/institutes receive **€1,500/semester/scholar**. Scholars who will have to travel to the host institution more than 1,500 km are also eligible for one-time **Travel Grant**.

Deadline for scholarship applications is **31 January annually**.
