CALL for APPLICATIONS

**for admission to the Postgraduate Doctoral Programme
in the academic year 2016/2017
in the scientific fields of Mechanical Engineering, Naval Architecture, Aeronautical Engineering and
Metallurgical Engineering**

The doctoral programme lasts six semesters.

The doctoral programme modules are as follows:

- **MECHATRONICS AND ROBOTICS**

- **COMPUTATIONAL MECHANICS**
- **PROCESS AND ENERGY ENGINEERING**
- **THEORY OF STRUCTURES**
- **SCIENTIFIC METROLOGY IN MECHANICAL ENGINEERING**
- **AERONAUTICAL ENGINEERING**

Entrance requirements:

Any person, who has completed a respective university graduate programme in the field of technical science and earned a total of at least 300 ECTS credits, obtained an desirable average grade at the undergraduate and graduate level equal to a very good mark or above, that is, the equivalent mark based on another evaluation system, is eligible to apply for the **Postgraduate Doctoral Programme**.

Admission may be granted also to persons who have completed a university graduate programme in another scientific field, provided differential exams are taken.

If a candidate has not graduated yet, but plans to do so during December 2016 instead of submitting a copy of the diploma, he/she may submit a statement stating their intention to graduate during December 2016.

The applicant must be proficient in English what will be examined during the admission procedure.

International students apply for admission at equal conditions as Croatian nationals.

TO APPLY YOU NEED TO SUBMIT:

Acompleted application form in English or Croatian along with:

- a research area proposal and selection of doctoral programme module
- a suggestion of a potential mentor

- a CV
- a list of published scientific and professional papers
- a statement on the planned source of tuition fees payment
- a copy of a diploma in Croatian or English
- a copy of a university undergraduate and graduate degree transcripts
- a statement indicating the intention to graduate by the December 4th (it applies to those who will graduate successively).

The Postgraduate University Study costs/tuition fees amount to HRK 10,000.00 per semester. Payment is due upon successful inscription.

The deadline to apply is **September 30th, 2016**.

The successful applicants shall submit all the required documentation for admission to the Postgraduate Studies Office of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture.
